Parks of St. Michaels

Hours: Dawn to Dusk

- 1. St. Michaels Nature Trail** – This 1.3-mile trail extends from Bradley Park off Railroad Avenue, with a parking area, and continues through and over San Domingo Tidal Creek via a covered bridge to the southern edge of town and a parking lot.
- 2. Back Creek Park** - A 0.3-acre park with a pier, kayak launch ramp, picnic tables, benches, toddler playground area and views of San Domingo Creek. Home of the Wilson “Bill” Shook Memorial Bridge, a covered bridge over the tidal creek.
- 3. Canton Farm Nature Preserve** - A forty-acre nature preserve and wildlife observation area.
- 4. Clint S. Bradley Park** - A two-acre park with playground areas, gazebo, picnic tables, trails and public restrooms.
- 5. Wilson Reading Garden** - A quarter-acre reading garden located adjacent to the St. Michaels Branch of the Talbot County Free Library. Benches, patio area and rain garden.
- 6. Perry Cabin Park** - This twenty-acre recreation facility includes baseball/softball fields, basketball court, playground equipment, sheltered picnic area, and public restrooms.
- 7. Frederick Douglass Park** - A 0.1-acre downtown seating area and information kiosk.
- 8. Hollis Park** - A 1.9-acre park on St. Michaels Harbor, home of the Town Office, with small playground, picnic tables and benches.
- 9. Skateboard Park** - A half-acre skateboarding area, public restrooms and parking.
- 10. Muskrat Park** - This half-acre park, renovated in 2010, has views of St. Michaels Harbor and is home to many community activities, such as the Saturday FreshFarm Market and Thursday-evening Concerts in the Park (seasonal). Landscaped beds, gazebo, picnic tables, benches and historic cannons.
- 11. St. Mary's Square and St. Michaels Museum** - A 0.3-acre park-like setting featuring two circa 1860 buildings filled with artifacts significant to the history and culture of the area.
- 12. Bay Hundred Community Pool** - A one-acre facility including an outdoor community pool – open June to September.
